- Emergency kit



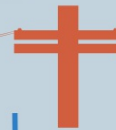
### Packing

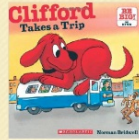

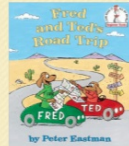

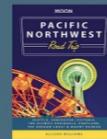
